The submission deadline for the Spring 2019 Journal is August 27th, 2018.

The *Journal of Politics & Society* is an interdisciplinary journal of undergraduate scholarship in the social sciences, published by the Helvidius Group of Columbia University. Founded in 1989, the *Journal* provides a forum for young scholars to contribute to the global dialogue on a diverse range of issues pertinent to the social sciences.

The Editorial Board of the Helvidius Group is seeking submissions of scholarly research from **UNDERGRADUATES** in colleges and universities around the world. Current undergraduates and recent graduates may submit work they completed as undergraduates. In addition, the *Journal of Politics & Society* will award a cash prize to the author of the article judged most worthy by the Editorial Board in conjunction with faculty at Columbia University.

The *Journal of Politics & Society* is seeking original, creative, and rigorous articles in the fields of political science, economics, sociology, history, psychology, linguistics, law, anthropology, criminology, cultural and area studies, development studies, and demography.

Students from **ALL SOCIAL SCIENCE DISCIPLINES** are encouraged to submit their work.

Submissions must be at least 20-25 double-spaced pages in length but there is no maximum number of pages. Papers selected for publication undergo an intensive peer review and editing process, which involves significant communication between the Editorial Board and the author. Work previously written for classroom or individual use is welcomed. It is mandatory that your submission be free of your university's name.
